



2017 REGISTRATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By registering with Lindisfarne Netball Club as a Member, 18 year of age or older or as the Parent/Guardian registering on behalf of a Member under 18 years of age, you acknowledge you have read, understood and agree to the below terms and conditions of registration with the Lindisfarne Netball Club.

POLICIES:

- You agree to abide by the Constitution and all Policies, Guidelines, By Laws and Codes of the Lindisfarne Netball Club, Tweed Netball Association, Netball QLD and Netball Australia, all of which are available for viewing and downloading from the Club, Association and governing body websites.

FEES:

- You understand payment for the season must be made at the time of registration.
- You acknowledge that a player MUST be registered with full payment before he/she can take the court for grading or participating.

UNIFORMS:

- You understand that all players must wear the Lindisfarne Netball Club uniform.

TEAM MANAGERS:

- You understand that all teams must have a Manager who is over the age of sixteen (16) years. In the case of Senior teams, a playing Member may act as a Manager. Teams will not be registered with our association without a volunteer Team Manager.

PHOTOGRAPHY:

- You also acknowledge that individual and/or team photographs and names may appear on the Tweed Netball Association website or on the Lindisfarne School website/newsletter/Facebook page and give permission for these images/names to appear.

INSURANCE:

- Your registration provides player insurance which falls under the school's insurance policy.

MEDICAL:

- You are aware of the risks of playing netball with a pre-existing medical condition.
- You give permission for the Club/Association to arrange any medical attention that may be required, including ambulance transport and you agree to pay all medical costs incurred by you/them.

REFUNDS:

- You understand that if you withdraw you/your child's Registration from the Lindisfarne Netball Club the fees are non-refundable.
- A full refund will only be granted to players if a registered player cannot be placed into a team.

GRADING AND TEAM FORMATION:

- You are aware that all players in U11+ Competition Teams will be expected to attend grading days unless otherwise notified.
- You acknowledge and accept all decisions made by the Club's Grading Committee on team selections. You recognise all is being done in the best interests of all players, all teams and the Club.
- Should the Club have insufficient NetSetGo and/or Junior registrations to form full or balanced teams, you agree to your child being placed in a composite team comprising players with similar skills and ability from two (2) age groups.

COMMITMENT:

- You understand that you are committing you/your child to the 2017 Winter Competition of netball as arranged by the Tweed Netball Association (TNA).
- You acknowledge that all players, NetSetGo U8-10 and Competition Teams U11+ are committed to training at least once a week as arranged by the coach of their team.
