## **Principal's COVID-19 Update 11 to the Community**

### **Queensland Lockdown Lifted**

The Queensland Government lockdown has been lifted from 4.00pm today Sunday, 8 August 2021. This means Lindisfarne students living in Queensland are able to return to school tomorrow Monday, 9 August ready for face to face learning.

The majority of regional Schools in New South Wales including Lindisfarne Anglican Grammar School operate under Level 2 restrictions with learning occurring at school.

The New South Wales Government Public Health Alert-Stay at Home Order which came into effect on 31 July remains in force and states anyone who has been in Queensland since Wednesday, 21 July, should stay at home until the order is revoked **or until 14 days has passed since they were last in an affected area.**

Under this Health Order, a reasonable excuse to leave your home includes work or education and that attending school or work has been confirmed as a reasonable excuse.

A reminder that masks are mandatory on all school transport services for secondary students Year 7 to 12. Students travelling on a Lindisfarne bus into New South Wales and then returning to Queensland are to ensure they have all the required border passes prior to boarding.
