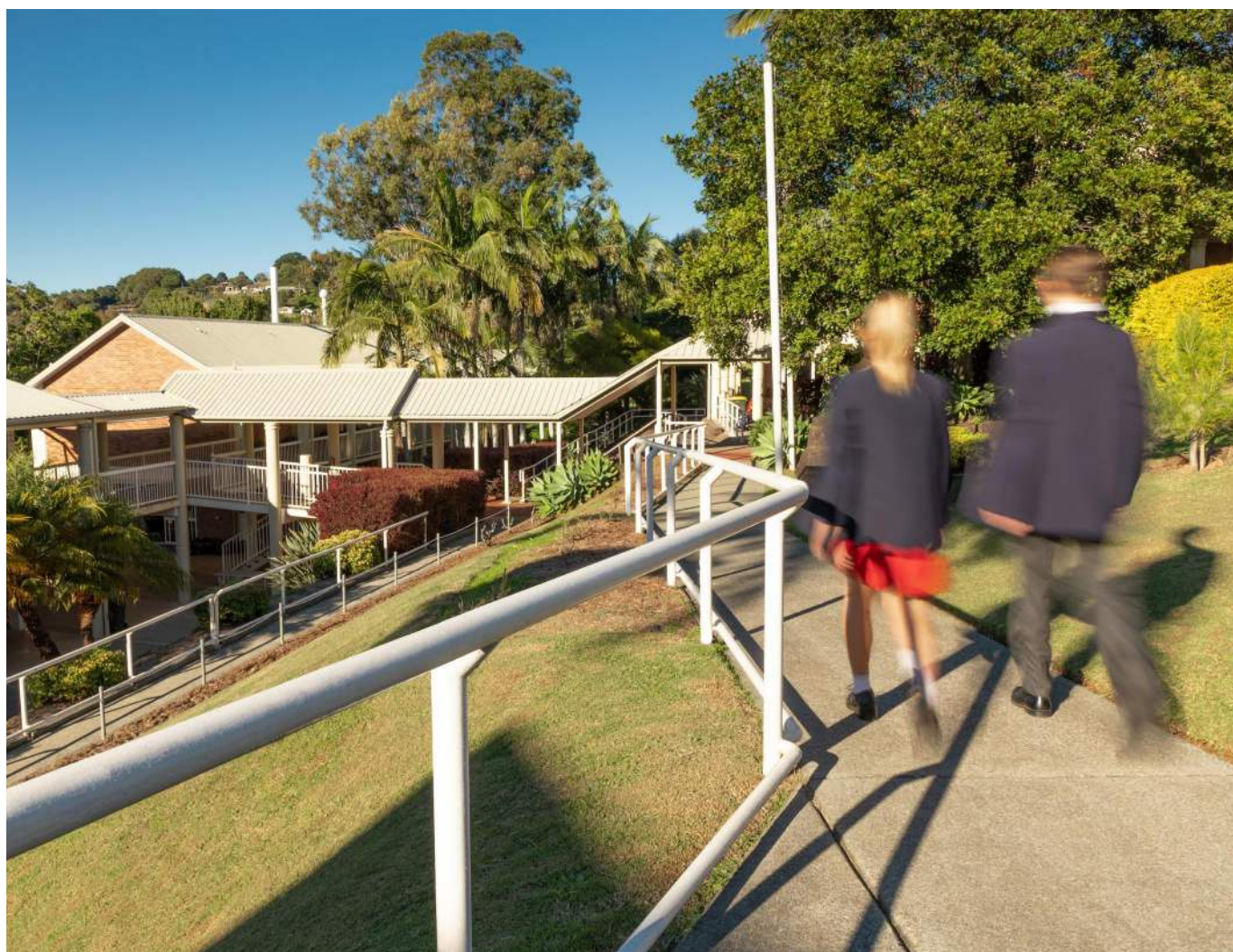

- Scientific calculator — Casio fx-82AU Plus II (second edition) — Year 8 only if a replacement calculator is required.
